❖ June 5 - World Environment Day

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Units (093 A & 093 B) of Al-Azhar College of Arts & Science observed World Environment Day on June 5th with an innovative and engaging campaign centered on the theme: "Plant a Fruit, Grow a Future!" July 12- paper bag day

The Al-Azhar Group of Institutions observed International Paper Bag Day on Friday, July 12, 2025, to promote sustainable practices and discourage the use of single-use plastic bags. The theme of the observance was centered around the quote: "Let's make conscious choices today for a sustainable tomorrow."


June 21- International Yoga Day



Major highlights of the camp included:


Free Dental Consultation: Patients received consultations at no charge.

SEPTEMBER 24 –WORLD NSS DAY



The celebration successfully instilled the core values of the NSS in the volunteers, encouraging them to commit to selfless service and community betterment.








September 25- Orientation Program for First Year volunteers

OCTOBER 15- "LIFESAVERS: EMERGENCY CARE"

The NSS Unit of Al-Azhar College of Arts and Science successfully organized a crucial one-day workshop titled "LIFESAVERS: EMERGENCY CARE" on Wednesday, October 15, 2025.

The workshop was conducted in collaboration with the experts from Al-Azhar Medical College and Super Speciality Hospital, and was held at the hospital premises.

The primary goal of the program was to train NSS volunteers and students in essential first aid and emergency life-saving techniques, such as Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), responding to choking, and managing common medical emergencies. The training aimed to equip participants with the skills necessary to provide immediate assistance during critical situations until professional medical help arrives.

The session included both theoretical instruction and practical, hands-on demonstrations led by medical professionals. The participants were given the opportunity to practice techniques, ensuring they gained confidence in administering emergency care.

The workshop was highly impactful, empowering the attendees to become proficient first responders and highlighting the importance of basic medical knowledge in saving lives.
